




Members will be recognized for their accomplishments throughout the 2022-2023 4-H year. The 4-H Council will provide a meal. Each family needs to bring a dessert.

It provides an opportunity for youth to be recognized for their accomplishments during their 4-H career, as well as develop their skills in record keeping, completing applications, and potentially interviewing.

Youth who complete the application will be recognized on the county and state levels.

Financial scholarships are awarded to youth who receive bronze, silver, gold, or emerald levels on the state level.


Youth can start the program at any time. Youth must be between 10-19 years old.

Kentucky 4-H Youth Development

Kentucky 4-H Achievement Application

Level	Requirements for that Level
Clover Level 1	 Be 10 years old by January 1, 2024 Have a minimum of 25 points
Clover Level 2	 Be 11 years old by January 1, 2024. Have a minimum of 50 points.
Clover Level 3	 Be 12 years old by January 1, 2024. Have a minimum of 75 points.
Bronze	 Be 13 years old by January 1, 2024. Have a minimum of 100 points. Have completed Bronze Profile Page.
Silver	 Be 14 years old by January 1, 2024. Have a minimum of 150 points. Have completed Silver Profile Page.
Gold	 Be 15 years old by January 1, 2024. Have a minimum of 200 points. Have completed Gold Profile Page.
Emerald	 Have previously achieved Gold Achievement Level. Be 16 years old by January 1, 2024. Have an updated application. Have a 3-5 minute video. Have two letters of recommendation. Have a cover letter and resume (these must be brought to the interview).

3 MINUTE APPLE PIE!



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Chop apples into tiny pieces and place into a bowl.
- 2. Sprinkle Sugars and Cinnamon on top of apples.
- 3. Microwave the apples for 1 minute, take out and stir, microwave for an additional minute.
- 4. Spread Cream Cheese on top of Graham Crackers.
- 5. Spoon cooked apple pieces onto cream cheese.

Optional: drizzle a small amount of chocolate and caramel on top.
